Drinks: A crémant will be offered as an aperitif, and white, rosé and red wines will be served with the meal. Beer, alcohol-free, soft drinks and water will also be available. Coffee and tea will be provided after the meal.

Prices: The all-inclusive price of the meal with crémant aperitif, wines, water and coffee/tea is €100. For participants who opt for the alcohol-free drinks, the all-inclusive price is €82.

Dress: For the men, black tie is preferred, alternatively a dark lounge suit and tie. For the ladies, appropriate evening wear.

Please note that the number of places is limited to 65. Initially, each society will have a quota of 20 places, so you should book early to avoid disappointment. When the quota for a society has been filled, further requests will be put on a reserve list, and if there are unallocated places from the other societies' quotas those places and the 5 that were kept in reserve will be allocated to the reserve list on a strict first-come-first-served basis.

Cancellations: any cancellation 8 working days or less before the event will not be reimbursed.
