About: Poulton Hall is a 17th Century country house. It is the third on the site, built in 1652, with additions in 1720, 1840, 1960, 1990 and 2024. The gardens are on a general theme of Children's Literature, covering a wide range of authors including the owner's father.

The site has been occupied by the same family for over 900 years.

Venue and Date:

Programme:

The numbers are limited to 20 split into two groups on a first come first served basis.

One group will tour the house whilst the other group will tour the garden.

Each tour will last about an hour before lunch. After lunch the groups will swap.

11.15 am Brief talk by the owner Scirard Lancelyn Green about the family history (both groups)

11.30-12.30 first tour (house or garden)

12.30- 1.30 lunch (both groups)

1.30-2.30 second tour (house or garden).

A light lunch of sandwiches, cake, tea or coffee will be provided.

The visit to the house includes stairs. There are accessible loos.

Poulton Hall is on the Wirral peninsular between Bebbington and Brombrough, 1.5 miles from M53 J4. The Postcode is CH63 9LN. The hall is 1 mile down from the start of Poulton Road and the entrance is at the junction of Poulton Road and Poulton Hall Road. Taller vehicles should go to the left of the wrought iron gates for 50 yards and take the next entrance to the right (white gates).
