**Autumn Dinner and Talk on “Absurdity in the Law” by
Adrian Salter (St John’s matric. 1969), Barrister, Musician and Author

Our speaker, Adrian Salter, was born in London and educated at Highgate School. At Cambridge he read French, German and Italian before switching to Law, which some felt was more appropriate to his argumentative disposition. He graduated in 1972 and was called to the Bar in 1973.

After starting as a barrister in the criminal courts, Adrian joined commercial chambers in Lincoln’s Inn. He then pursued his career in civil litigation, also lecturing regularly in professional negligence, contract law and tort and chairing a Legal Aid appeals panel. The variety of his cases provided a rich source of unusual material for his lectures and an occasional use for his languages.

In parallel to the Law, Adrian has pursued an active musical life, singing in leading choirs in London and latterly in Cheltenham, and as a pianist, for which he was a prize-winner at the 2023 Cheltenham Festival of Performing Arts. Adrian’s comic novel, “*In Two Minds*,” concerning the redemption of a chronically indecisive TEFL teacher, was published in 2017.

Adrian and his wife Louise moved from London to Cheltenham in 2021 and are already known to us from their attendance at recent events.
