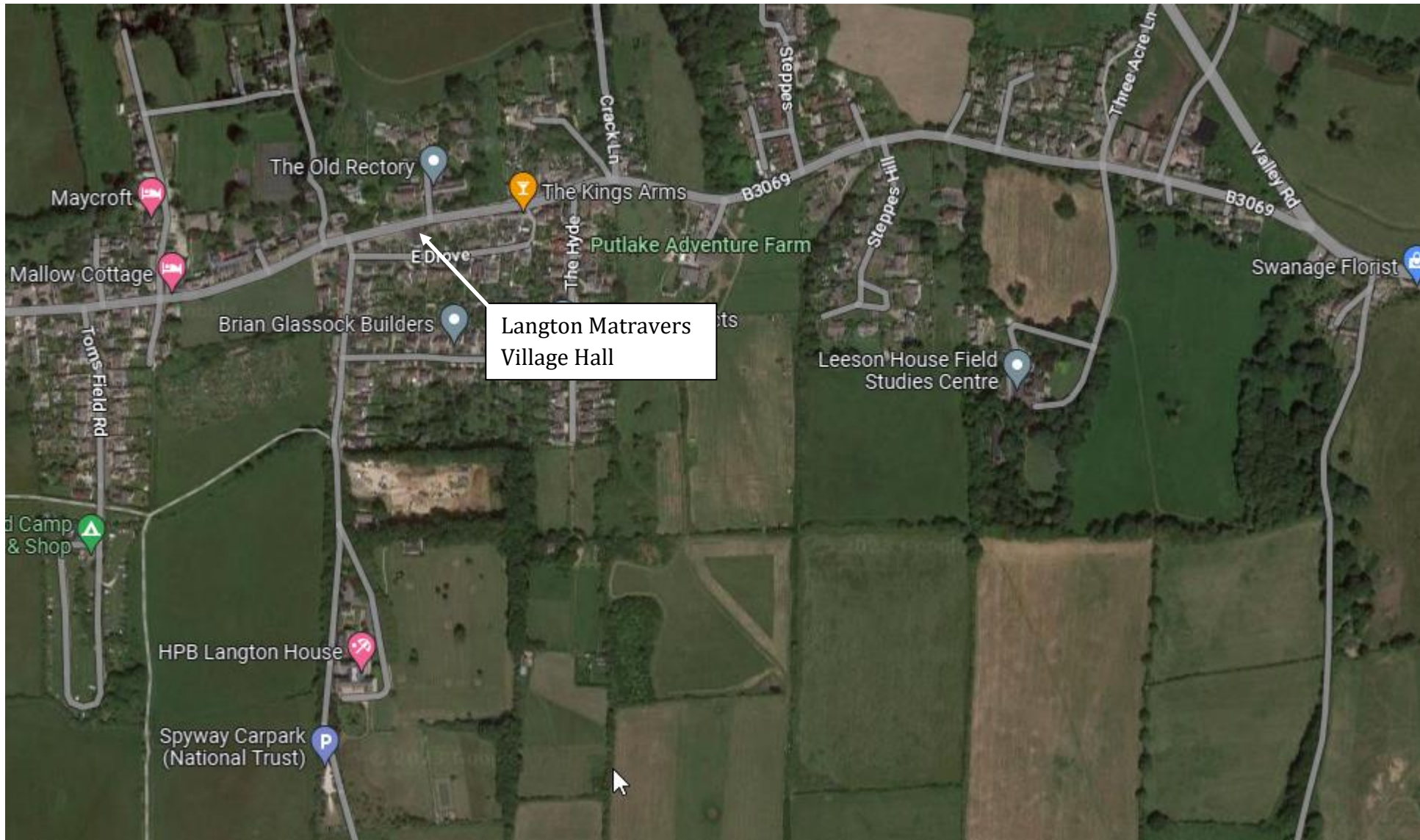

There is no dedicated car-parking for the Village Hall. There is some on-street parking on the High St, immediately outside the Hall, and more within a few yards.

**We ask that you only use this if you have limited mobility.**

The main parking is the National Trust 'Spyway' car park, seen at the lower left of the map. This is about a 10 minute walk from the Hall (500 metres). Current charges are £2 for 4 hours, free to NT members. The road to the car park is Durnford Drive, and is signposted to Langton House. There may also be some spaces available in Durnford Drive, closer to the Hall, but again, if you are able to walk from the car-park, please leave these nearer spaces for those with less mobility.

If anyone with limited mobility does have a problem finding suitable parking on the day, call me (David) on 07885 777426, and we will try to arrange a lift from the car-park.
